Mr. RODRIGUEZ introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Natural Resources

A BILL

To authorize the expansion of the Fort Davis National
Historic Site in Fort Davis, Texas, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INCREASED ACREAGE OF THE FORT DAVIS NA-**
4 **TIONAL HISTORIC SITE.**

5 Public Law 87–213 (16 U.S.C. 461 note) is amended
6 as follows:

7 (1) In the first section—

8 (A) by striking “the Secretary of the Inte-
9 rior” and inserting “(a) The Secretary of the
10 Interior”;

1 (B) by striking “476 acres” and inserting
2 “646 acres”; and

3 (C) by adding at the end the following:

4 “(b) The Secretary may acquire from willing sellers
5 land comprising approximately 55 acres, as depicted on
6 the map titled ‘Fort Davis Proposed Boundary Expan-
7 sion’, numbered 418/80,045, and dated April 2008. The
8 map shall be on file and available for public inspection
9 in the appropriate offices of the National Park Service.
10 Upon acquisition of the land, the land shall be incor-
11 porated into the Fort Davis National Historic Site.”.

12 (2) By repealing section 3.

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
