A BILL

To amend the Emergency Economic Stabilization Act of 2008 to restrict the use of TARP funds for domestic purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as "The Responsible Use of
- 5 Taxpayer Help Act".

1	SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT TO USE TARP FUNDS FOR DOMES-
2	TIC PURPOSES.
3	Title I of the Emergency Economic Stabilization Act
4	of 2008 is amended by adding at the end the following
5	new section:
6	"SEC. 137. REQUIREMENT TO USE TARP FUNDS FOR DO-
7	MESTIC PURPOSES.
8	"A financial institution shall not use any assistance
9	provided under this title to—
10	"(1) purchase or invest in any foreign asset or
11	business;
12	"(2) transfer money to, or invest in, a foreign
13	subsidiary of the financial institution;
14	"(3) pay any type of compensation to an em-
15	ployee of the financial institution unless such em-
16	ployee is a United States citizen or lawful perma-
17	nent resident; or
18	"(4) make any other purchase, payment, trans-
19	fer, or investment, the primary effect of which is to
20	benefit a foreign entity.".
