A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act with respect to payment for the furnishing of intravenous immune globulin (IVIG) in a patient's home for the treatment of primary immune deficiency diseases and to cover certain disposable pumps as durable medical equipment in place of non-disposable pumps under the Medicare Program.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1	SECTION 1. MEDICARE PAYMENT FOR ITEMS AND SERV-
2	ICES RELATING TO THE FURNISHING OF IN-
3	TRAVENOUS IMMUNE GLOBULIN (IVIG) IN A
4	PATIENT'S HOME FOR THE TREATMENT OF
5	PRIMARY IMMUNE DEFICIENCY DISEASES.
6	(a) Coverage.—Section 1861 of the Social Security
7	Act (42 U.S.C. 1395x) is amended—
8	(1) in subsection $(s)(2)(Z)$ by inserting "and
9	items and services related to the administration of
10	intravenous immune globulin" after "globulin"; and
11	(2) in subsection (zz), by striking ", but not in-
12	cluding items or services related to the administra-
13	tion of the derivative,".
14	(b) Payment.—Section 1842(o) of such Act (42
15	U.S.C. 1395u(o)) is amended—
16	(1) in paragraph (7)—
17	(A) by striking "(6)" and inserting "(7)";
18	and
19	(B) by redesignating such paragraph as
20	paragraph (8); and
21	(2) by inserting after paragraph (6) the fol-
22	lowing new paragraph:
23	"(7)(A) Subject to subparagraph (B), in the case of
24	intravenous immune globulins furnished on or after Janu-
25	ary 1, 2010, under section $1861(s)(2)(Z)$, the Secretary
26	shall provide for a separate payment for items and services

- 1 related to the administration of such intravenous immune
- 2 globulins in an amount that the Secretary determines to
- 3 be appropriate based on a review of available published
- 4 and unpublished data and information, including the
- 5 Study of Intravenous Immune Globulin Administration
- 6 Options: Safety, Access, and Cost Issues (CMS Contract
- 7 #500-95-0059). Such payment amount may take into ac-
- 8 count the following:
- 9 "(i) Pharmacy overhead and related expenses.
- 10 "(ii) Patient service costs.
- 11 "(iii) Supply costs.
- 12 "(B) The separate payment amount under this para-
- 13 graph for intravenous immune globulins furnished in 2011
- 14 or a subsequent year shall be equal to the separate pay-
- 15 ment amount determined under this paragraph for the
- 16 previous year increased by the percentage increase in the
- 17 consumer price index for medical care for the 12-month
- 18 period ending with June of the previous year.".
- 19 SEC. 2. MEDICARE COVERAGE OF DISPOSABLE PUMPS AS
- 20 ITEMS OF DURABLE MEDICAL EQUIPMENT IN
- 21 CERTAIN CASES.
- 22 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1861(n) of the Social Se-
- 23 curity Act (42 U.S.C. 1395x(n)) is amended by inserting
- 24 before the semicolon the following: "and includes a dispos-
- 25 able pump prescribed, instead of a non-disposable external

- 1 infusion pump, for administration of a drug used as part
- 2 of a chemotherapy regimen for the treatment of colorectal
- 3 cancer if a non-disposable external infusion pump would
- 4 have been covered under this subsection to administer the
- 5 same drug for the same indication as of July 1, 2008".
- 6 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 7 subsection (a) shall apply to disposable pumps furnished
- 8 on or after January 1, 2010.
