A BILL

To ensure States receive adoption incentive payments for fiscal year 2008 in accordance with the Fostering Connections to Success and Increasing Adoptions Act of 2008.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protecting Incentives
5 for the Adoption of Children with Special Needs Act of
6 2009”.

1 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF RESTRICTION ON PAYMENTS FOR**
2 **FISCAL YEAR 2008.**

3 Effective as if included in the enactment of the Omni-
4 bus Appropriations Act, 2009 (Public Law 111–8), title
5 II of division F of such Act is amended under the heading
6 “CHILDREN AND FAMILIES SERVICES PROGRAMS” under
7 the heading “ADMINISTRATION FOR CHILDREN AND FAM-
8 ILIES”, by striking “That without regard to the fiscal year
9 limitations set forth in section 473A of the Social Security
10 Act, from the amounts appropriated herein, the Secretary
11 shall pay adoption incentives for fiscal year 2008 in the
12 same manner as such incentives were awarded in fiscal
13 year 2008 for the previous fiscal year: *Provided further,*”.
