To designate certain counties in the State of Arizona as high-intensity drug trafficking areas.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Southwest Border Nar-
5 cotics Reduction Act of 2009”.

6 **SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF HIGH-INTENSITY DRUG TRAF-**
7 **FICKING AREAS IN ARIZONA.**

8 The counties of Apache, Gila, Coconino, Yavapai,
9 Navajo, Graham, and Greenlee in the State of Arizona are
10 designated as high-intensity drug trafficking areas and

- 1 shall be part of the Southwest Border high-intensity drug
- 2 trafficking area under the program administered by the
- 3 Office of National Drug Control Policy.
