To designate certain counties in the State of Arizona as high-intensity drug trafficking areas.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Southwest Border Nar-
- 5 cotics Reduction Act of 2009".
- 6 SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF HIGH-INTENSITY DRUG TRAF-
- 7 FICKING AREAS IN ARIZONA.
- 8 The counties of Apache, Gila, Coconino, Yavapai,
- 9 Navajo, Graham, and Greenlee in the State of Arizona are
- 10 designated as high-intensity drug trafficking areas and

- 1 shall be part of the Southwest Border high-intensity drug
- 2 trafficking area under the program administered by the

3 Office of National Drug Control Policy.
