A BILL

To make the repeal of the estate tax permanent.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Permanent Death Tax
5 Repeal Act of 2009”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF ESTATE TAX MADE PERMANENT.**

7 Section 901 of the Economic Growth and Tax Relief
8 Reconciliation Act of 2001 shall not apply to title V of
9 such Act.
