## A BILL

To prohibit funding organizations that support or participate in coercive abortion or involuntary sterilization.

- Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

  SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON FUNDING ORGANIZATIONS

  THAT SUPPORT OR PARTICIPATE IN COERCIVE ABORTION OR INVOLUNTARY STERILIZATION.

  (a) PROHIBITION.—Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Secretary of State may not make a con-
- 10 tion or program that supports or participates in the man-

tribution, whether voluntary or assessed, to any organiza-

- 1 agement of a program of coercive abortion or involuntary
- 2 sterilization.
- 3 (b) Definition.—In this section, the term "supports
- 4 or participates in" includes providing material, financial,
- 5 or technical support to any government, agency, or non-
- 6 governmental organization that enforces or implements a
- 7 program that includes coercive abortion or involuntary
- 8 sterilization (or any government agency or nongovern-
- 9 mental organization that controls, is controlled by, or is
- 10 under common control of such government or agency).
