3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Northern California
- 5 Ocean and Coastal Protection Act".

SEC. 2. PROHIBITION OF OIL AND GAS LEASING IN CER TAIN AREAS OF THE OUTER CONTINENTAL SHELF.

4 Section 8 of the Outer Continental Shelf Lands Act
5 (43 U.S.C. 1337) is amended by adding at the end the
6 following:

"(q) PROHIBITION OF OIL AND GAS LEASING IN 7 8 CERTAIN AREAS OF THE OUTER CONTINENTAL SHELF.— 9 "(1) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act or any other law and except as 10 11 provided in paragraph (2), beginning on the date of 12 enactment of this subsection, the conduct of oil and 13 gas preleasing, leasing, and related activities is pro-14 hibited in areas of the outer Continental Shelf lo-15 cated off the coast of Mendocino, Humboldt, and 16 Del Norte Counties in the State of California.

17 "(2) EFFECT.—Nothing in this subsection af18 fects any rights under leases issued under this Act
19 before the date of enactment of this subsection.".

20 SEC. 3. COMPREHENSIVE INVENTORY OF OUTER CONTI-21 NENTAL SHELF OIL AND NATURAL GAS RE-22 SOURCES.

23 Section 357(a) of the Energy Policy Act of 2005 (42
24 U.S.C. 15912(a)) is amended by inserting after "Conti25 nental Shelf" the following: "(other than the areas of the

1 Outer Continental Shelf off the coast of Mendocino, Hum-

2 boldt and Del Norte Counties in the State of California)".
