To amend the National Guard Youth Challenge Program under title 32, United States Code, to exclude nondefense funds made available by other Federal agencies for the Program from the matching requirements of the Program.

3 **SECTION 1. FEDERAL ASSISTANCE FOR STATE PROGRAMS**

4 **UNDER THE NATIONAL GUARD YOUTH CHAL-**
5 **LENCE PROGRAM.**

6 (a) FEDERAL SHARE OF COSTS OF STATE PRO-
7 GRAMS.—Subsection (d) of section 509 of title 32, United

1 States Code, as amended by section 594 of Public Law
2 110–417 (122 Stat. 4475), is amended by adding at the
3 end the following new paragraph:

4 “(3) Nondefense funds made available or transferred
5 to the Secretary of Defense by other Federal agencies to
6 support the Program shall not be subject to the matching-
7 funds requirement imposed by paragraph (1).”.

8 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—For fis-
9 cal year 2010, there is authorized to be appropriated to
10 the Secretary of Defense \$97,527,200 to carry out the Na-
11 tional Guard Youth Challenge Program under section 509
12 of title 32, United States Code.

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
