A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to conduct a study on the acquisition of a parcel of land adjacent to Beaufort National Cemetery, Beaufort, South Carolina.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. STUDY ON ACQUISITION OF LAND ADJACENT**
4 **TO BEAUFORT NATIONAL CEMETERY.**

5 (a) STUDY REQUIRED.—The Secretary of Veterans
6 Affairs shall conduct a study on the acquisition, in accord-
7 ance with chapter 24 of title 38, United States Code, of
8 the parcel of land described in subsection (b) to be used

1 for the expansion of the Beaufort National Cemetery,
2 Beaufort, South Carolina.

3 (b) PARCEL DESCRIBED.—The parcel of land de-
4 scribed in this subsection is a parcel of land consisting
5 of approximately 4.9 acres located on 17th Street in Beau-
6 fort, South Carolina, as depicted on tax map number 120-
7 1-238 dated May 4, 1998.

8 (c) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—Not later than 30 days
9 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary
10 of Veterans Affairs shall submit to Congress a report on
11 the study conducted under subsection (a).

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
