A BILL

To provide for the limitation on entry of steel, drywall, and cement products that fail to meet industry standards.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON ENTRY OF STEEL, DRYWALL,**
4 **AND CEMENT PRODUCTS THAT FAIL TO MEET**
5 **INDUSTRY STANDARDS.**

6 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Sec-
7 retary of Homeland Security shall direct the Commis-
8 sioner responsible for U.S. Customs and Border Protec-
9 tion, at the discretion of the Commissioner, to prohibit the
10 entry into the United States of steel, drywall, and cement

- 1 products that do not meet appropriate industry standards
- 2 to ensure product quality and safety.
