A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a study of water resources in the State of California, and for other purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Inland Empire Per-5 chlorate Ground Water Plume Assessment Act of 2009".

6 SEC. 2. INLAND EMPIRE WATER RESOURCES STUDY.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 2 years after funds
8 are made available for this Act, the Secretary of the Inte9 rior, acting through the Director of the United States Geo10 logical Survey (referred to in this Act as the "Secretary"),

in this Act as the "State") and any other entities that 2 the Secretary determines to be appropriate (including other Federal agencies and institutions of higher education), shall complete a study of water resources in the State, including—

7 (1) a survey of ground water resources, includ-8 ing an analysis of—

9 (A) the delineation, either horizontally or 10 vertically, of the aquifers in the Rialto-Colton 11 basin within the State, including the quantity of 12 water in the aquifers;

13 (B) the availability of ground water re-14 sources for human use;

15 (C) the salinity of ground water resources; 16 (D) the identification of a recent surge in 17 perchlorate concentrations in ground water, 18 whether significant sources are being flushed 19 through the vadose zone, or if perchlorate is 20 being remobilized;

21 (E) the identification of impacts and 22 extents of all source areas that contribute to 23 the regional plume to be fully characterized;

24 (F) the potential of the ground water re-25 sources to recharge;

1	(G) the interaction between ground water
2	and surface water;
3	(H) the susceptibility of the aquifers to
4	contamination, including identifying the extent
5	of commingling of plume emanating within sur-
6	rounding areas in San Bernardino County,
7	California; and
8	(I) any other relevant criteria; and
9	(2) a characterization of surface and bedrock
10	geology, including the effect of the geology on
11	ground water yield and quality.
12	(b) STUDY AREAS.—The study carried out under
13	subsection (a) shall include the Rialto-Colton Basin in the
14	State.
15	(c) REPORT.—Not later than 2 years after funds are
16	made available for this Act, the Secretary shall submit to
17	the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources of the
18	Senate and the Committee on Natural Resources of the
19	House of Representatives a report that describes the re-
20	sults of the study.
