A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Army to retain funds collected from recreation fees at Lake Texoma to repair flood-damaged recreation facilities.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. DISPOSITION OF RECREATION FEES AT LAKE
- 4 TEXOMA.
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Funds generated by fees collected
- 6 during fiscal years 2010 through 2015 for entering or
- 7 being admitted to public recreation areas at Denison Dam,
- 8 Lake Texoma, Texas and Oklahoma, or for using recre-
- 9 ation facilities located in such areas, shall be retained by
- 10 the Secretary of the Army and shall be used to cover the

- 1 cost of repairing damages to any federally owned recre-
- 2 ation structure, facility, or real property managed by the
- 3 Secretary at Lake Texoma that was damaged as a result
- 4 of flooding that occurred at the Lake prior to September
- 5 30, 2007.
- 6 (b) Funds Available to Secretary.—The funds
- 7 referred to in subsection (a) shall be deposited into a spe-
- 8 cial account established in the Treasury of the United
- 9 States and shall be available to the Secretary of the Army
- 10 without further appropriation for use by the Secretary as
- 11 specified in subsection (a), except that any funds that re-
- 12 main available after September 30, 2021, shall be depos-
- 13 ited into the special account established in the Treasury
- 14 under section 4(i)(1) of the Land and Water Conservation
- 15 Fund Act of 1965.
