## **AN ACT**

- To expand the research and awareness activities of the National Institute of Arthritis and Musculoskeletal and Skin Diseases and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention with respect to scleroderma, and for other purposes.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

## 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 2 This Act may be cited as the "Scleroderma Research
- 3 and Awareness Act of 2010".
- 4 SEC. 2. NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF ARTHRITIS AND MUS-
- 5 CULOSKELETAL AND SKIN DISEASES;
- 6 SCLERODERMA RESEARCH EXPANSION.
- 7 Part B of title IV of the Public Health Service Act
- 8 (42 U.S.C. 284 et seq.) is amended by adding at the end
- 9 the following:
- 10 "SEC. 409K. SCLERODERMA RESEARCH.
- 11 "The Director of NIH may expand, intensify, and co-
- 12 ordinate the activities of the National Institutes of Health
- 13 with respect to scleroderma, with particular emphasis on
- 14 the following:
- "(1) Research focused on the etiology of
- scleroderma and the development of new treatment
- options.
- 18 "(2) Clinical research to evaluate new treat-
- ments options.
- 20 "(3) Basic research on the relationship between
- 21 scleroderma and secondary conditions such as pul-
- 22 monary hypertension, gastroparesis, Raynaud's phe-
- nomenon, Sjögren's Syndrome, and other diseases as
- 24 determined by the Director.".

1	SEC. 3. PROMOTING PUBLIC AWARENESS OF
2	SCLERODERMA.
3	Part P of title III of the Public Health Service Act
4	(42 U.S.C. 280g et seq.) is amended by adding at the end
5	the following:
6	"SEC. 399V-5. PROMOTING PUBLIC AWARENESS OF
7	SCLERODERMA.
8	"The Secretary may carry out an educational cam-
9	paign to increase public awareness of scleroderma. Print,
10	video, and Web-based materials distributed through this
11	campaign may include—
12	"(1) basic information on scleroderma and its
13	symptoms; and
14	"(2) information on—
15	"(A) the incidence and prevalence of
16	scleroderma;
17	"(B) diseases and conditions affiliated with
18	scleroderma; or
19	"(C) the importance of early diagnosis and
20	treatment of scleroderma.".
