A BILL

To amend title 49, United States Code, to require inclusion on the no fly list certain detainees housed at the Naval Air Station, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SECURING AVIATION FROM EXTREME TER-
- 4 RORIST THREATS.
- 5 Section 44903(j)(2)(C) of title 49, United States
- 6 Code, is amended by adding at the end the following:
- 7 "(v) Inclusion of Detainees on No
- 8 FLY LIST.—The Assistant Secretary, in co-

ordination with the Terrorist Screening 1 2 Center, shall include on the no fly list any 3 individual who was a detainee housed at the Naval Station, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, on or after January 1, 2009. For purposes of this clause, the term 'detainee' 6 means an individual in the custody or 7 under the physical control of the United 8 States as a result of armed conflict.". 9
