A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Defense to ensure the members of the Armed Forces receive mandatory hearing screenings before and after deployments and to direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to mandate that tinnitus be listed as a mandatory condition for treatment by the Department of Veterans Affairs Auditory Centers of Excellence and that research on the preventing, treating, and curing of tinnitus be conducted.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Veterans Hearing and3 Assessment Act".

4 SEC. 2. SENSE OF CONGRESS.

5 It is the sense of Congress that tinnitus is one of the
6 leading service-connected disability issues that is not being
7 addressed.

8 SEC. 3. MANDATORY HEARING EVALUATIONS FOR MEM9 BERS OF THE ARMED FORCES.

10 The Secretary of Defense shall ensure that each 11 member of the Armed Forces receives a hearing evaluation 12 that includes a screening for tinnitus before the member 13 is deployed and after the member returns from a deploy-14 ment.

15 SEC. 4. RESEARCH AND TREATMENT OF TINNITUS BY SEC 16 RETARY OF VETERANS AFFAIRS.

17 (a) RECOGNITION.—The Secretary of Veterans af18 fairs shall recognize tinnitus as a mandatory condition for
19 research and treatment by the Department of Veterans
20 Affairs Auditory Centers of Excellence.

(b) RESEARCH.—The Secretary for Veterans Affairs
shall ensure that research is conducted at Department of
Veterans Affairs facilities on the prevention, treatment,
and curing of tinnitus.
