## A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to provide for the establishment and maintenance of an undiagnosed diseases registry.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Charles August 'CAL'
- 5 Long Undiagnosed Diseases Registry Act of 2009".
- 6 SEC. 2. REGISTRY OF UNDIAGNOSED DISEASES.
- 7 (a) In General.—Title III of the Public Health
- 8 Service Act (42 U.S.C. 241 et seq.) is amended by insert-
- 9 ing after section 317T the following:

## 1 "SEC. 317U. UNDIAGNOSED DISEASES REGISTRY.

- 2 "(a) Establishment.—The Secretary, acting
- 3 through the Director of the Centers for Disease Control
- 4 and Prevention, shall establish and maintain an
- 5 undiagnosed diseases registry (in this section referred to
- 6 as the 'registry').
- 7 "(b) Content of Registry.—The Secretary shall
- 8 include in the registry such information respecting
- 9 undiagnosed diseases as the Secretary deems appropriate
- 10 for the purpose of facilitating the early recognition, pre-
- 11 vention, treatment, cure, and control of such diseases.
- 12 "(c) Availability.—For the purpose described in
- 13 subsection (b), the Secretary may make the information
- 14 in the registry publicly available, except the Secretary
- 15 shall not publicly disclose—
- 16 "(1) individually identifiable information; or
- 17 "(2) trade secrets or commercial or financial in-
- formation obtained from a person and privileged or
- confidential, as provided in section 552(b)(4) of title
- 5, United States Code.
- 21 "(d) Authorization of Appropriations.—To
- 22 carry out this section, there are authorized to be appro-
- 23 priated \$5,000,000 for fiscal year 2010 and such sums
- 24 as may be necessary for each of fiscal years 2011 through
- 25 2015.".

- 1 (b) First Operation of Registry.—The Secretary
- 2 of Health and Human Services, acting through the Direc-
- 3 tor of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention,
- 4 shall ensure that the undiagnosed diseases registry estab-
- 5 lished pursuant to section 317U of the Public Health
- 6 Service Act, as added by subsection (a), becomes oper-
- 7 ational not later than one year after the date of the enact-
- 8 ment of this Act.
