AN ACT

To ensure that the right of an individual to display the Service Flag on residential property not be abridged.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2	This Act may be cited as the "Blue Star/Gold Star		
3	Flag Act of 2010".		
4	SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.		
5	For purposes of this Act—		
6	(1) the term "Service Flag" has the meaning		
7	given such term under section 901 of Public Lav		
8	105–225 (36 U.S.C. 901);		
9	(2) the terms "condominium association" and		
10	"cooperative association" have the meanings given		
11	such terms under section 604 of Public Law 96–399		
12	(15 U.S.C. 3603);		
13	(3) the term "residential real estate manage-		
14	ment association" has the meaning given such term		
15	under section 528 of the Internal Revenue Code of		
16	1986 (26 U.S.C. 528); and		
17	(4) the term "member"—		
18	(A) as used with respect to a condominium		
19	association, means an owner of a condominium		
20	unit (as defined under section 604 of Public		
21	Law 96–399 (15 U.S.C. 3603)) within such as-		
22	sociation;		
23	(B) as used with respect to a cooperative		
24	association, means a cooperative unit owner (as		
25	defined under section 604 of Public Law 96–		

- 1 399 (15 U.S.C. 3603)) within such association; 2 and
- (C) as used with respect to a residential real estate management association, means an owner of a residential property within a subdivision, development, or similar area subject to any policy or restriction adopted by such association.

9 SEC. 3. RIGHT TO DISPLAY THE SERVICE FLAG.

A condominium association, cooperative association, or residential real estate management association may not adopt or enforce any policy, or enter into any agreement, that would restrict or prevent a member of the association from displaying the Service Flag on residential property within the association with respect to which such member has a separate ownership interest or a right to exclusive possession or use.

18 SEC. 4. LIMITATIONS.

- Nothing in this Act shall be considered to permit any display or use that is inconsistent with—
- 21 (1) any regulations prescribed by the United 22 States Secretary of Defense regarding rules or cus-23 toms pertaining to the proper display or use of the 24 Service Flag; or

1	(2) any reas	sonable restriction pertaining to the	
2	time, place, or m	anner of displaying the Service Flag	
3	necessary to pro	otect a substantial interest of the	
4	condominium association, cooperative association, or		
5	residential real es	state management association.
