- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Optometric Equity in
- 5 Medicaid Act of 2009".

1	SEC. 2. REQUIRING MEDICAID COVERAGE OF PROFES-
2	SIONAL SERVICES OF OPTOMETRISTS THAT
3	ARE OTHERWISE COVERED WHEN FUR-
4	NISHED BY A PHYSICIAN.
5	(a) In General.—Section 1905(a)(5) of the Social
6	Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396d(a)(5)) is amended—
7	(1) by striking "and" before "(B)"; and
8	(2) by inserting before the semicolon at the end
9	the following: ", and (C) medical and other health
10	services as defined in section 1861(s) and as author-
11	ized by State law, furnished by an optometrist (de-
12	scribed in section $1861(r)(4)$ ) to the extent such
13	services may be performed under State law either by
14	a doctor of medicine or by a doctor of optometry and
15	would be described in clause (A) if furnished by a
16	physician (as defined in section $1861(r)(1)$ )".
17	(b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
18	subsection (a) shall take effect on the date of the enact-
19	ment of this Act.
