Mr. CROWLEY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the

A BILL

For the relief of Llesh Miraj, Enkeleda Miraj, Michaela Miraj, Vanessa Miraj, and Sabrina Miraj.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR LLESH**

4 **MIRAJ, ENKELEDA MIRAJ, MICHAELA MIRAJ,**

5 **VANESSA MIRAJ, AND SABRINA MIRAJ.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)
7 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality
8 Act, Llesh Miraj, Enkeleda Miraj, Michaela Miraj,
9 Vanessa Miraj, and Sabrina Miraj shall each be eligible
10 for issuance of an immigrant visa or for adjustment of

1 status to that of an alien lawfully admitted for permanent
2 residence upon filing an application for issuance of an im-
3 migrant visa under section 204 of such Act or for adjust-
4 ment of status to lawful permanent resident.

5 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Llesh Miraj,
6 Enkeleda Miraj, Michaela Miraj, Vanessa Miraj, or
7 Sabrina Miraj enters the United States before the filing
8 deadline specified in subsection (c), he or she shall be con-
9 sidered to have entered and remained lawfully and shall,
10 if otherwise eligible, be eligible for adjustment of status
11 under section 245 of the Immigration and Nationality Act
12 as of the date of the enactment of this Act.

13 (c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
14 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-
15 plication for issuance of an immigrant visa or the applica-
16 tion for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees
17 within 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.

18 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBER.—
19 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent res-
20 idence to Llesh Miraj, Enkeleda Miraj, Michaela Miraj,
21 Vanessa Miraj, and Sabrina Miraj, the Secretary of State
22 shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by 5, during the
23 current or next following fiscal year, the total number of
24 immigrant visas that are made available to natives of the
25 country of the aliens' birth under section 203(a) of the

1 Immigration and Nationality Act or, if applicable, the
2 total number of immigrant visas that are made available
3 to natives of the country of the aliens' birth under section
4 202(e) of such Act.

5 (e) DENIAL OF PREFERENTIAL IMMIGRATION
6 TREATMENT FOR CERTAIN RELATIVES.—The natural
7 parents, brothers, and sisters of Llesh Miraj, Enkeleda
8 Miraj, Michaela Miraj, Vanessa Miraj, and Sabrina Miraj
9 shall not, by virtue of such relationship, be accorded any
10 right, privilege, or status under the Immigration and Na-
11 tionality Act.

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
