## AN ACT

To correct and simplify the drafting of section 1752 (relating to restricted buildings or grounds) of title 18, United States Code.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Federal Restricted  
3 Buildings and Grounds Improvement Act of 2010”.

4 **SEC. 2. RESTRICTED BUILDINGS OR GROUNDS.**

5 Section 1752 of title 18, United States Code, is  
6 amended to read as follows:

7 **“§ 1752. Restricted buildings or grounds**

8 “(a) Whoever—

9 “(1) knowingly enters or remains in any re-  
10 stricted building or grounds without lawful authority  
11 to do so;

12 “(2) knowingly, and with intent to impede or  
13 disrupt the orderly conduct of Government business  
14 or official functions, engages in disorderly or disrup-  
15 tive conduct in, or within such proximity to, any re-  
16 stricted building or grounds when, or so that, such  
17 conduct, in fact, impedes or disrupts the orderly con-  
18 duct of Government business or official functions;

19 “(3) knowingly, and with the intent to impede  
20 or disrupt the orderly conduct of Government busi-  
21 ness or official functions, obstructs or impedes in-  
22 gress or egress to or from any restricted building or  
23 grounds; or

24 “(4) knowingly engages in any act of physical  
25 violence against any person or property in any re-  
26 stricted building or grounds;

1 or attempts or conspires to do so, shall be punished as  
2 provided in subsection (b).

3 “(b) The punishment for a violation of subsection (a)  
4 is—

5 “(1) a fine under this title or imprisonment for  
6 not more than 10 years, or both, if—

7 “(A) any person, during and in relation to  
8 the offense, uses or carries a deadly or dan-  
9 gerous weapon or firearm; or

10 “(B) the offense results in significant bod-  
11 ily injury as defined by section 2118(e)(3); and

12 “(2) a fine under this title or imprisonment for  
13 not more than one year, or both, in any other case.

14 “(c) In this section—

15 “(1) the term ‘restricted buildings or grounds’  
16 means a posted, cordoned off, or otherwise restricted  
17 area of a building or grounds—

18 “(A) where the President or other person  
19 protected by the Secret Service is or will be  
20 temporarily visiting; or

21 “(B) so restricted in conjunction with an  
22 event designated as a special event of national  
23 significance; and

24 “(2) the term ‘other person protected by the  
25 Secret Service’ means any person whom the United

1 States Secret Service is authorized to protect under  
2 section 3056 of this title when such person has not  
3 declined such protection.”.

4 **SEC. 3. PAYGO COMPLIANCE.**

5 The budgetary effects of this Act, for the purpose of  
6 complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010,  
7 shall be determined by reference to the latest statement  
8 titled “Budgetary Effects of PAYGO Legislation” for this  
9 Act, submitted for printing in the Congressional Record  
10 by the Chairman of the House Budget Committee, pro-  
11 vided that such statement has been submitted prior to the  
12 vote on passage.
