## A BILL

To amend the Truth in Lending Act to prohibit prepayment penalties, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Promoting Mortgage
- 5 Responsibility Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON PREPAYMENT PENALTIES.
- 7 The Truth in Lending Act (15 U.S.C. 1601 et seq.)
- 8 is amended by inserting after section 129A the following
- 9 new section:

### 1 "SEC. 129B. PROHIBITION ON PREPAYMENT PENALTIES.

- 2 "(a) In General.—No prepayment fees or penalties
- 3 may be charged or collected under the terms of any con-
- 4 sumer credit transaction secured by an owner-occupied
- 5 principal dwelling of the consumer.
- 6 "(b) Unenforceable.—Any prepayment penalty in
- 7 violation of subsection (a) shall be unenforceable.".
