To amend title XIX of the Social Security Act to require 12-month continuous coverage for children under Medicaid.

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Ensuring Continuous
- 5 Medicaid Coverage for Children Act of 2009".
- 6 SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT OF 12-MONTH CONTINUOUS COV-
- 7 ERAGE FOR CHILDREN UNDER MEDICAID.
- 8 (a) In General.—Section 1902 of the Social Secu-
- 9 rity Act (42 U.S.C. 1396a) is amended—
- 10 (1) in subsection (a)—

1	(A) by striking "and" at the end of para-
2	graph (72);
3	(B) by striking the period at the end of
4	paragraph (73) and inserting "; and; and
5	(C) by inserting after paragraph (73) the
6	following new paragraph:
7	"(74) meet the requirement of subsection
8	(e)(12)."; and
9	(2) in subsection (e)(12), by striking "At the
10	option of a State, the plan may" and inserting "The
11	State plan under this title shall".
12	(b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
13	subsection (a) shall take effect on October 1, 2009, and
14	shall apply to individuals who were determined eligible for
15	medical assistance before, on, or after such date.
