A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to provide for a Medicare operated prescription drug plan option to deliver a meaningful drug benefit and lower prescription drug prices under the Medicare Program.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Medicare Drug Savings
- 5 Through Choice Act of 2009".

1 SEC. 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF MEDICARE OPERATED PRE-

- 2 SCRIPTION DRUG PLAN OPTION.
- 3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subpart 2 of part D of the Social
- 4 Security Act is amended by inserting after section 1860D-
- 5 11 (42 U.S.C. 1395w–111) the following new section:
- 6 "MEDICARE OPERATED PRESCRIPTION DRUG PLAN
- 7 OPTION
- 8 "Sec. 1860D-11A. (a) In General.—Notwith-
- 9 standing any other provision of this part, for each year
- 10 (beginning with 2010), in addition to any plans offered
- 11 under section 1860D–11, the Secretary shall offer a Medi-
- 12 care operated prescription drug plan (as defined in sub-
- 13 section (b)) with a service area that consists of the entire
- 14 United States.
- 15 "(b) Medicare Operated Prescription Drug
- 16 Plan Defined.—For purposes of this part, the term
- 17 'Medicare operated prescription drug plan' means a pre-
- 18 scription drug plan that offers qualified prescription drug
- 19 coverage and access described in section 1860D–2(d) to
- 20 the prices negotiated under subsection (c)(1). Such plan
- 21 may offer supplemental prescription drug coverage in the
- 22 same manner as other qualified prescription drug coverage
- 23 offered by other prescription drug plans.
- 24 "(c) Enhanced Affordability Through Nego-
- 25 TIATIONS.—

- "(1) In General.—Notwithstanding section 1860D–11(i), for purposes of offering the Medicare operated prescription drug plan under this section, the Secretary shall negotiate with pharmaceutical manufacturers with respect to the purchase price of such covered part D drugs and shall encourage the use of more affordable therapeutic equivalents to the extent such practices do not override medical neces-sity as determined by the prescribing physician.
 - "(2) IMPLEMENTATION OF OTHER COST SAVINGS STRATEGIES.—To the extent practicable and
 consistent with paragraph (1), the Secretary shall
 implement strategies similar to those used by the
 Department of Veterans Affairs or other Federal
 purchasers of prescription drugs, and other strategies, to reduce the purchase cost of covered part D
 drugs.
 - "(3) CONDITIONING USE OF FORMULARIES.—
 Insofar as the Medicare operated prescription drug
 plan uses a formulary, such plan shall inform, consistent with section 1860D–4(a)(3)(B), enrollees of
 changes in such formulary, including changes in covered drugs and the prices of such drugs.
 - "(4) SAVINGS USED TO FILL GAPS IN PRE-SCRIPTION DRUG COVERAGE.—Any savings to the

Medicare operated prescription drug plan resulting from actions take under this subsection shall be used by the plan to extend coverage under the plan to individuals who have reached the initial coverage limit applicable under the plan but who have not reached the annual out-of-pocket threshold specified in section 1860D-2(b)(4)(B).

"(d) Monthly Premiums.—

"(1) For qualified prescription drug coverage.—

"(A) NATIONALLY UNIFORM MONTHLY BENEFICIARY PREMIUM.—The monthly beneficiary premium for qualified prescription drug coverage and access to negotiated prices described in section 1860D–2(a)(1)(A) to be charged under the Medicare operated prescription drug plan shall be uniform nationally.

"(B) BID BASED ON COSTS.—The bid submitted under section 1860D–11(b)(2)(C) for the Medicare operated prescription drug plan shall be based on the average monthly per capita actuarial cost of offering such plan for the year involved, including administrative expenses.

1	"(2) Supplemental prescription drug cov-
2	ERAGE.—Insofar as the Medicare operated prescrip-
3	tion drug plan offers supplemental prescription drug
4	coverage, the Secretary shall adjust the amount of
5	the bid submitted under section $1860D-11(b)(2)(C)$
6	(and the premium charged under paragraph (1)) to
7	reflect the additional benefits offered under such
8	coverage.
9	"(e) Open Enrollment.—A part D eligible indi-
10	vidual may enroll in the Medicare operated prescription
11	drug plan at any time.".
12	(b) No Late Enrollment Penalty for Individ-
13	UALS ENROLLED IN MEDICARE OPERATED PRESCRIP-
14	TION DRUG PLAN.—Section 1860D-13(b)(2) of such Act
15	(42 U.S.C. 1395w-113(b)(2)) is amended by adding at
16	the end the following new sentence: "A part D eligible in-
17	dividual described in this paragraph does not include an
18	individual enrolled in the Medicare operated prescription
19	drug plan during the period in which the individual is so
20	enrolled.".
21	(c) Conforming Amendments.—
22	(1) Section $1860D-1(b)(1)(B)(iii)$ of the Social
23	Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395w–101(b)(1)(B)(iii)) is
24	amended by inserting "and section 1860D-11A(e)"

15	(ii), the Medicare operated prescription
16	drug plan shall be offered in addition to
17	any qualifying plan or fallback prescription
18	drug plan offered in a PDP region and
19	shall not be considered to be such a plan

23	PLAN.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
24	sion of this part, the Secretary may des-
25	ignate the Medicare operated prescription

3	fined in section $1860D-11(g)(3)$ deter-
4	mined to be appropriate by the Sec-
5	retary.".

8	(A) in the heading, by inserting "AND THE
9	MEDICARE OPERATED PRESCRIPTION DRUG
10	PLAN" after "FALLBACK PLANS"; and
11	(B) by inserting "or the Medicare operated
12	prescription drug plan" after "a fallback pre-
13	scription drug plan".
