# A BILL

To appropriate to the Highway Trust Fund the unobligated balances of funds made available by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Highway Trust Fund
- 5 Reclamation Act".

#### SEC. 2. APPROPRIATION OF UNOBLIGATED STIMULUS

- 2 FUNDS TO HIGHWAY TRUST FUND.
- 3 (a) Rescissions.—Effective on July 15, 2009, any
- 4 unobligated balances available on such date of funds made
- 5 available by division A of the American Recovery and Re-
- 6 investment Act of 2009 (Public Law 111–5), other than
- 7 under the heading "Federal Highway Administra-
- 8 TION—HIGHWAY INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT" in title
- 9 XII of such division (123 Stat. 106), are rescinded.
- 10 (b) Appropriation to Highway Trust Fund.—
- 11 Effective on July 15, 2009, there is appropriated to the
- 12 Highway Trust Fund established by section 9503 of the
- 13 Internal Revenue Code of 1986, out of money in the
- 14 Treasury not otherwise appropriated, the total amount re-
- 15 scinded by subsection (a).
