## A BILL

To require that household cleaning products and similar products bear a label that contains a complete and accurate list of all the product's ingredients.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Household Product  
5 Labeling Act of 2009”.

6 **SEC. 2. LABELING REQUIREMENT FOR CERTAIN HOUSE-**  
7 **HOLD PRODUCTS.**

8 (a) LABELING REQUIREMENT.—Any household  
9 cleaning product or similar product shall bear a label on

1 the product’s container or packaging that contains a com-  
2 plete and accurate list of all the product’s ingredients. Be-  
3 ginning on the date that is 1 year after the date of enact-  
4 ment of this Act, any household cleaning product or simi-  
5 lar product that is manufactured for sale, offered for sale,  
6 distributed in commerce, or imported to the United States  
7 without such a label shall be treated as a misbranded haz-  
8 ardous substance within the meaning of section 2(p) of  
9 the Federal Hazardous Substances Act (15 U.S.C.  
10 1261(p)).

11 (b) DEFINITION OF HOUSEHOLD CLEANING PROD-  
12 UCT OR SIMILAR PRODUCT.—As used in this Act, the term  
13 “household cleaning product or similar product” means  
14 any substance which is customarily produced and distrib-  
15 uted for use in or about a household as a cleaning agent,  
16 pesticide, epoxy, paint or stain, or similar substance.

17 (c) RULEMAKING AUTHORITY.—The Consumer Prod-  
18 uct Safety Commission may issue such regulations as it  
19 determines necessary to provide for the effective enforce-  
20 ment of this Act, including regulations which expand on  
21 or exempt from the definition in subsection (b) any prod-  
22 uct or product category.
