## A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to improve and expand education savings accounts.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "401Kids Family Sav-
- 5 ings Act of 2009".
- 6 SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF DATE FOR SUNSET OF CERTAIN
- 7 EDUCATION SAVINGS INCENTIVES.
- 8 In the case of the provisions of, and amendments
- 9 made by, section 401 of the Economic Growth and Tax

1	Relief Reconciliation Act of 2001 (relating to modifica-
2	tions to education individual retirement accounts), section

4	shall be applied by substituting "December 31, 2015" for

6	SEC. 3. DISTRIBUTIONS FROM EDUCATION SAVINGS AC-
7	COUNTS FOR FIRST HOME PURCHASES
8	TREATED AS QUALIFIED DISTRIBUTIONS.
9	(a) In General.—Subsections (b)(1), (d)(2)(A),
10	(d)(2)(B), (d)(2)(C)(ii)(II), and (d)(2)(D) of section 530
