- 7 COSTS MADE PERMANENT.
- 8 (a) Provision Made Permanent.—Section 198 of
- 9 the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (relating to expensing

- 1 of environmental remediation costs) is amended by strik-
- 2 ing subsection (h).
- 3 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 4 this section shall apply to expenditures paid or incurred

5 after December 31, 2009.
