- 3 SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF ROBLEY REX DEPARTMENT
- 4 OF VETERANS AFFAIRS MEDICAL CENTER.
- 5 (a) Designation.—The Department of Veterans Af-
- 6 fairs Medical Center in Louisville, Kentucky, and any suc-
- 7 cessor to such medical center, shall after the date of the

- 1 enactment of this Act be known and designated as the
- 2 "Robley Rex Department of Veterans Affairs Medical
- 3 Center".
- 4 (b) References.—Any reference in any law, regula-
- 5 tion, map, document, record, or other paper of the United
- 6 States to the medical center referred to in subsection (a)
- 7 shall be considered to be a reference to the Robley Rex
- 8 Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Center.
