- 3 SECTION 1. POSTPONEMENT OF WAGE INCREASE.
- 4 Section 6(a)(1)(C) of the Fair Labor Standards Act
- 5 of 1938 (29 U.S.C. 206(a)(1)(C)) is amended by striking
- 6 "beginning 24 months after that 60th day" and inserting
- 7 "July 24, 2010".
