- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "FLTFA Reauthoriza-
- 5 tion Act of 2009".
- 6 SEC. 2. FEDERAL LAND TRANSACTION FACILITATION ACT
- 7 AMENDMENTS.
- 8 The Federal Land Transaction Facilitation Act (43
- 9 U.S.C. 2301 et seq.) is amended as follows:

1	(1) In section 203(2), by striking "on the date
2	of enactment of this Act was" and inserting "is".
3	(2) In section 205(a), by striking "(as in effect
4	on the date of enactment of this Act)".
5	(3) By striking subsection (d) of section 205.
6	(4) By striking subsection (f) of section 206.
7	(5) In section 207(b)—
8	(A) By striking "under—" and inserting
9	"under the following:".
10	(B) In paragraph (1), by striking "; and"
11	and inserting a period.
12	(C) By amending paragraph (2) to read as
13	follows:
14	"(2) Public Law 105–263 (the Southern Ne-
15	vada Public Land Management Act of 1998 (112
16	Stat. 2343)), as amended.".
17	(D) By adding at the end of subsection
18	(b), the following:
19	"(3) Sections 301 through 307 of Public Law
20	109-432 (commonly known as the 'White Pine
21	County Conservation, Recreation, and Development
22	Act of 2006' (120 Stat. 3028)).

"(4) Public Law 108–424 (commonly known as
the 'Lincoln County Conservation, Recreation, and
Development Act of 2004' (118 Stat. 2403)).".
