4	(a) Exclusion.—Section 1503(a) of title 38, United
5	States Code, is amended—
6	(1) by striking "and" at the end of paragraph
7	(9);
8	(2) by redesignating paragraph (10) as para-
9	graph (11); and
10	(3) by inserting after paragraph (9) the fol-
11	lowing new paragraph (10):
12	"(10) payment of a monetary amount to a vet-
13	eran from a State or municipality that is paid as a
14	veterans' benefit; and".
15	(b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
16	subsection (a) shall apply with respect to determinations
17	of income for calendar years beginning after the date of
18	the enactment of this Act.
