To amend title 18, United States Code, to prevent misrepresentation of their ages by on-line predators as a means for the entirement of children.

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Capturing On-line
- 5 Predators Act of 2009".
- 6 SEC. 2. MISREPRESENTATION OF AGE BY ON-LINE PREDA-
- 7 TORS.
- 8 (a) Offense.—Chapter 117 of title 18, United
- 9 States Code, is amended by inserting after section 2422
- 10 the following:

1 "§ 2422A. Misrepresentation of age by on-line preda-

2 tors

3 "(a) Whoever, being 18 years of age or older, know-

4 ingly misrepresents their age in an on-line communication

5 to a minor to persuade, induce, entice, or coerce any indi-

6 vidual to engage in any sexual activity for which any per-

7 son can be charged with a criminal offense, or attempts

8 to do so, shall be fined under this title or imprisoned for

9 not more than 10 years, or both. A defendant sentenced

10 to imprisonment under this section shall serve that sen-

11 tence consecutively to any sentence of imprisonment im-

12 posed for any other offense in the same criminal episode.

13 "(b) As used in this section, the term 'on-line commu-

14 nication' means any communication over the Internet.".
