- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Nutritious Food for
- 5 Health Families Act of 2009".
- 6 SEC. 2. AMENDMENT.
- 7 Section 7(g)(2)(A)(ii) of the Food and Nutrition Act
- 8 of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2016(g)(2)(A)(ii)) is amended by strik-
- 9 ing "40" and inserting "17".

1 SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE; APPLICATION OF AMENDMENT.

- 2 (a) Effective Date.—Except as provided in sub-
- 3 section (b), this Act and the amendments made by this
- 4 Act shall take effect 90 days after the date of the enact-
- 5 ment of this Act.
- 6 (b) Application of Amendment.—The amendment
- 7 made by this Act shall not apply with respect to certifi-
- 8 cation periods that begin before the effective date of this
- 9 Act.
