AN ACT

- To require the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to include on the main page of the Internet website of the Department of Veterans Affairs a hyperlink to the VetSuccess Internet website and to publicize such Internet website.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1SECTION 1. PROMOTION OF THE VETSUCCESS INTERNET2WEBSITE.

3 (a) INCLUSION OF HYPERLINK.—Not later than 60 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-4 5 retary of Veterans Affairs shall include on the main page of the Internet website of the Department of Veterans Af-6 7 fairs a new hyperlink with a drop-down menu entitled 8 "Veterans Employment". The drop-down menu shall in-9 clude a direct hyperlink to the VetSuccess Internet 10 website, the USA Jobs Internet website, the Job Central website, and any other appropriate employment Internet 11 websites, as determined by the Secretary, especially such 12 websites that focus on jobs for veterans. 13

(b) ADVERTISEMENT OF INTERNET WEBSITE.—Subject to the availability of appropriations for such purpose,
the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall, in accordance with
section 532 of title 38, United States Code, purchase advertising in national media outlets for the purpose of promoting awareness of the VetSuccess Internet website to
veterans.

(c) OUTREACH TO VETERANS OF OPERATION IRAQI
FREEDOM AND OPERATION ENDURING FREEDOM.—The
Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall conduct outreach to
veterans of Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom to inform such veterans of the VetSuccess
Internet website.

(d) VETSUCCESS INTERNET WEBSITE DEFINED.—In
 this section, the term "VetSuccess Internet website"
 means www.vetsuccess.gov or any successor Internet
 website maintained by the Department of Veterans Af fairs.
