# H. R. 3691

To extend to 2010 the program for economic recovery payments established under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.

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## A BILL

To extend to 2010 the program for economic recovery payments established under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Seniors and Veterans  
5 Economic Stimulus Act of 2009”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF ECONOMIC RECOVERY PAYMENTS**  
2 **TO 2010.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2201 of the American Re-  
4 covery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 is amended—

5 (1) in subsection (a)(1)(A)—

6 (A) by inserting “in each of calendar years  
7 2009 and 2010” after “the Secretary of the  
8 Treasury shall disburse”; and

9 (B) by inserting “(for purposes of pay-  
10 ments made for calendar year 2009), or the 3-  
11 month period beginning with December 2009  
12 (for purposes of payments made for calendar  
13 year 2010)” after “the month that includes the  
14 date of the enactment of this Act”;

15 (2) in subsection (a)(1)(B)(iii), by inserting  
16 “(for purposes of payments made under this para-  
17 graph for calendar year 2009), or the 3-month pe-  
18 riod beginning with December 2009 (for purposes of  
19 payments made for calendar year 2010)” after “the  
20 month that includes the date of the enactment of  
21 this Act”;

22 (3) in subsection (a)(3)—

23 (A) by inserting “IN 1 YEAR” after “NO  
24 DOUBLE PAYMENTS” in the heading; and

25 (B) by adding at the end the following new  
26 sentence: “An individual who is entitled to, or

1 eligible for, a benefit or cash payment described  
2 in paragraph (1) in both of the 3-month periods  
3 described in paragraph (1)(A) shall be paid a  
4 payment under this section in each of calendar  
5 years 2009 and 2010.”;

6 (4) in subsection (a)(4)(A), by inserting “appli-  
7 cable” before “3-month period”;

8 (5) in subsection (a)(4)(B), by inserting “appli-  
9 cable” before “3 month period”;

10 (6) in subsection (a)(5)(B), by inserting “for  
11 purposes of payments made for calendar year 2009,  
12 or after December 31, 2011, for purposes of pay-  
13 ments made for calendar year 2010,” after “Decem-  
14 ber 31, 2010,”; and

15 (7) in subsection (e), by striking “2011” and  
16 inserting “2012”.

17 (b) FUNDING.—

18 (1) IN GENERAL.—Effective on November 30,  
19 2009, of the unobligated balance of the discretionary  
20 appropriations made available by division A of the  
21 American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009  
22 (Public Law 111–5), there is rescinded the amount  
23 determined by the Director of the Office of Manage-  
24 ment and Budget to be required to offset the in-

1       crease in spending resulting from the amendments  
2       made by subsection (a).

3           (2) APPLICATION.—The rescission made by  
4       paragraph (1) shall be applied proportionately—

5           (A) to each discretionary account; and

6           (B) within each such account, to each pro-  
7       gram, project, and activity (with programs,  
8       projects, and activities as delineated in the ap-  
9       propriation Act or accompanying reports for the  
10      relevant fiscal year covering such account, or  
11      for accounts not included in appropriation Act,  
12      as delineated in the most recently submitted  
13      President’s budget).

14          (3) OMB REPORT.—Within 30 days after the  
15      date of the enactment of this Act, the Director of  
16      the Office of Management and Budget shall submit  
17      to the House of Representatives and the Senate a  
18      report specifying the reductions made to each ac-  
19      count, program, project, and activity pursuant to  
20      this subsection.

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
