- To amend the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act and the Child Nutrition Act of 1966 to increase the number of children eligible for free school meals.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

  - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
  - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Expand School Meals
  - 5 Act of 2009".
  - 6 SEC. 2. FREE LUNCH ELIGIBILITY.
