## A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to authorize the reimbursement of mental health counselors under TRICARE, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SERVICES OF MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELORS.**

4       (a) REIMBURSEMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH COUN-  
5       SELORS UNDER TRICARE.—

6               (1) REIMBURSEMENT UNDER TRICARE.—Sec-  
7       tion 1079(a)(8) of title 10, United States Code, is  
8       amended—

9               (A) by inserting “or licensed or certified  
10       mental health counselors” after “certified mar-

riage and family therapists” both places it appears; and

(B) by inserting “or licensed or certified mental health counselors” after “that the therapists”.

(2) AUTHORITY TO ASSESS MEDICAL OR PSYCHOLOGICAL NECESSITY OF SERVICE OR SUPPLY.—Section 1079(a)(13) of such title is amended by inserting “, licensed or certified mental health counselor,” after “certified marriage and family therapist”.

(b) SERVICES OF MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELORS.—

(1) AUTHORITY TO ENTER INTO PERSONAL SERVICES CONTRACTS.—Section 704(c)(2) of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 1995 (Public Law 103–337; 108 Stat. 2799; 10 U.S.C. 1091 note) is amended by inserting “mental health counselors,” after “psychologists,”.

(2) APPLICABILITY OF LICENSURE REQUIREMENT FOR HEALTH-CARE PROFESSIONALS.—Section 1094(e)(2) of title 10, United States Code, is amended by inserting “mental health counselor,” after “psychologist,”.

(c) REPORTS.—

1           (1) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after  
2           the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary  
3           of Defense shall submit to Congress a report on the  
4           implementation of the amendments made by this  
5           section.

6           (2) UPDATED REPORT.—Not later than one  
7           year after the date of the enactment of this Act, the  
8           Secretary shall submit to Congress an update to the  
9           report submitted under paragraph (1).
