- 3 SECTION 1. COMMERCIALLY INTERCHANGEABLE MER-
- 4 CHANDISE FOR DUTY DRAWBACK PURPOSES.
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 313(j) of the Tariff Act
- 6 of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1313(j)) is amended by adding at the
- 7 end the following new paragraph:
- 8 "(5) For purposes of this subsection, merchan-
- 9 dise is 'commercially interchangeable' with imported

- 1 merchandise if it is classifiable under the same 8-
- 2 digit subheading of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule
- of the United States.".
- 4 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 5 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to claims filed for
- 6 drawback under section 313(j) of the Tariff Act of 1930
- 7 on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
