A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, with respect to organized retail theft, and for other purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Organized Retail5 Crime Prevention and Enforcement Act of 2009".

6 SEC. 2. TRANSPORT OF GOODS FOR SALE ON ONLINE MAR-

7 **KETPLACE**.

8 Section 2314 of title 18, United States Code, is9 amended—

(1) by striking the one-m dash at the end of the
 5th paragraph and inserting "; or"; and

3 (2) by inserting after the 5th paragraph the fol-4 lowing:

5 "Whoever transports, transmits, or transfers in inter6 state or foreign commerce any goods, wares, or merchan7 dise, of the value of \$1,000 or more, for sale on an online
8 marketplace, knowing the same to have been stolen, con9 verted, or taken by fraud—".

10 SEC. 3. SALE OF GOODS ON ONLINE MARKETPLACE.

11 Section 2315 of title 18, United States Code, is12 amended—

(1) by striking the one-m dash at the end of the
3rd paragraph and inserting "; or"; and

(2) by inserting after the 3rd paragraph the fol-lowing:

17 "Whoever by means of an online marketplace barters
18 or sells any goods, wares, or merchandise, of a value of
19 \$1,000 or more, knowing the same to have been stolen,
20 converted, or taken by fraud, or attempts to do so—".

21 SEC. 4. DEFINITIONS FOR NEW OFFENSES.

22 Section 2311 of title 18, United States Code, is23 amended—

(1) by inserting after the paragraph ending
 with "running on land but not on rails" the fol lowing:

4 "'Online marketplace' means an Internet site, or col5 lection of Internet sites with a common operator, whose
6 primary purpose is to facilitate transactions between peo7 ple for the sale of goods and services;".

8 (2) by inserting after the paragraph ending
9 with "or the carcass or carcasses thereof" the fol10 lowing:

11 "'Internet site' means a web site or location on the 12 Internet that is accessible at a specific Internet domain 13 name, is accessible at a specific address under the Internet 14 Protocol (or any successor protocol), or is identified by 15 a uniform resource locator;".

16 SEC. 5. ORGANIZED RETAIL CRIME TASK FORCES.

17 (a) ESTABLISHMENT.—The Attorney General shall 18 establish multi-jurisdictional task forces to initiate investigations of organized retail theft and dismantle organized 19 retail theft criminal enterprises in the six United States 20 21 district court districts with the greatest incidence of orga-22 nized retail theft, as determined by the Attorney General. 23 (b) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—The Attorney General 24 shall report annually to Congress on the activities of the 25 task forces established under this section.

(c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
 are authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section
 \$5,000,000 for fiscal year 2011 and for each of the 4 suc ceeding fiscal years.
