- 6 enue Code of 1986 is amended by striking "equal to—
- 7 " and all that follows through "of the total wages" and
- 8 inserting the following: "equal to 6.0 percent of the total
- 9 wages".

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 2 this section shall apply to wages paid during months be-

3 ginning after the date of the enactment of this Act.
