To amend title 49, United States Code, to make it an unfair or deceptive practice for any air carrier, foreign air carrier, or ticket agent to charge a fee for or accept payment from a passenger on a flight segment for the first piece of checked baggage.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "The First Bag Flies
- 5 Free Act".

1 SEC. 2. UNFAIR OR DECEPTIVE PRACTICE.

- 2 (a) No Cost for First Piece of Checked Bag-
- 3 GAGE.—Section 41712 of title 49, United States Code, is
- 4 amended by adding at the end the following:
- 5 "(c) No Cost for First Piece of Checked Bag-
- 6 GAGE.—It shall be an unfair or deceptive practice under
- 7 subsection (a) for any air carrier, foreign air carrier, or
- 8 ticket agent to charge a fee for or accept payment from
- 9 a passenger on a flight segment for the first piece of
- 10 checked baggage that weighs 50 pounds or less and for
- 11 which the size does not exceed 62 inches (determined by
- 12 adding the length, width, and height together).".
- 13 (b) Effective Date.—The requirements of section
- 14 41712 of title 49, United States Code, shall become effec-
- 15 tive on December 15, 2009, or on the date of enactment
- 16 of this Act, whichever is later.
