- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Feed All Struggling
- 5 Americans Act of 2009".
- 6 SEC. 2. AMENDMENT.
- 7 Section 5(d) of the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008
- 8 (7 U.S.C. 2014(d)) is amended—
- 9 (1) in paragraph (18) by striking "and" at the
- 10 end,

1	(2) in paragraph (19) by striking the period at
2	the end and inserting "; and", and
3	(3) by adding at the end the following:
4	"(29) unemployment benefits received for a
5	continuous period exceeding 26 weeks.".
6	SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE; APPLICATION OF AMENDMENTS.
7	(a) Effective Date.—Except as provided in sub-
8	section (b), this Act and the amendments made by this
9	Act shall take effect on the 1st day of the 1st month that
10	begins more that 90 days after the date of the enactment
11	of this Act.
12	(b) Application of Amendments.—The amend-
13	ments made by this Act shall not apply with respect to
14	certification periods that expire before the 1st day of the
15	1st month that begins more that 90 days after the effec-
