- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Brownfield Cleanup
- 5 Enhancement Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. BROWNFIELDS SITE ASSESSMENT AND CLEANUP.

- 5 this subsection \$350,000,000 for fiscal year 2010,
- 6 \$400,000,000 for fiscal year 2011, \$450,000,000 for
- 7 fiscal year 2012, \$500,000,000 for fiscal year 2013,
- 8 \$550,000,000 for fiscal year 2014, and
- 9 \$600,000,000 for fiscal year 2015 and each fiscal
- 10 year thereafter.".

- 19 2011, \$90,000,000 for fiscal year 2012,
- 20 \$100,000,000 for fiscal year 2013, \$110,000,000 for
- 21 fiscal year 2014, and \$120,000,000 for fiscal year
- 22 2015 and each fiscal year thereafter.".
