Mr. CASTLE introduced the following bill; which was referred to the

A BILL

To extend the temporary duty suspension on certain rayon
staple fibers.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON CERTAIN RAYON**
4 **STAPLE FIBERS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.23.33 of the Har-
6 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
7 certain staple fibers of viscose rayon, not carded, combed,
8 or otherwise processed for spinning, measuring 1.67 to
9 16.67 decitex and having a fiber length each measuring
10 20 mm or more but not over 150 mm (provided for in

1 subheading 5504.10.00)) is amended by striking “12/31/
2 2009” and inserting “12/31/2011”.

3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
4 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn
5 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
6 after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
