AN ACT

To revise the boundaries of the Gettysburg National Military
Park to include the Gettysburg Train Station, and for
other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. GETTYSBURG NATIONAL MILITARY PARK**

4 **BOUNDARY REVISION.**

5 Section 1 of the Act titled “An Act to revise the
6 boundary of the Gettysburg National Military Park in the
7 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and for other purposes”,

1 approved August 17, 1990 (16 U.S.C. 430g–4), is amend-
2 ed by adding at the end the following:

3 “(d) ADDITIONAL LAND.—In addition to the land
4 identified in subsections (a) and (b), the park shall also
5 include the following, as depicted on the map titled ‘Get-
6 tysburg National Military Park Proposed Boundary Addi-
7 tion’, numbered 305/80,045 and dated January 2010:

8 “(1) The land and interests in land commonly
9 known as the ‘Gettysburg Train Station’ and its im-
10 mediate surroundings in the Borough of Gettysburg.

11 “(2) The land and interests in land located
12 along Plum Run in Cumberland Township.”.

13 **SEC. 2. ACQUISITION AND DISPOSAL OF LAND.**

14 Section 2 of that Act (16 U.S.C. 430g–5) is amended
15 by adding at the end of subsection (a) the following: “The
16 Secretary is also authorized to acquire publicly owned
17 property within the area defined in section 1(d)(1) by pur-
18 chase, from willing sellers only, if efforts to acquire that
19 property without cost have been exhausted. The Secretary
20 may not acquire property within the area defined in sec-
21 tion 1(d) by eminent domain.”.
