# A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to authorize grants to provide treatment for diabetes in minority communities.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Minority Diabetes Ini-
- 5 tiative Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. GRANTS REGARDING TREATMENT OF DIABETES IN
- 7 **MINORITY COMMUNITIES.**
- 8 Part D of title III of the Public Health Service Act
- 9 (42 U.S.C. 254b et seq.) is amended by inserting after
- 10 section 330L the following:

#### 1 "SEC. 330M. GRANTS REGARDING TREATMENT OF DIABE-

- 2 TES IN MINORITY COMMUNITIES.
- 3 "(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary may make grants
- 4 to public and nonprofit private health care providers for
- 5 the purpose of providing treatment for diabetes in minor-
- 6 ity communities.
- 7 "(b) RECIPIENTS OF GRANTS.—The public and non-
- 8 profit private health care providers to whom grants may
- 9 be made under subsection (a) include physicians, podia-
- 10 trists, community-based organizations, health care organi-
- 11 zations, community health centers, and State, local, and
- 12 tribal health departments.
- 13 "(c) Scope of Treatment Activities.—The Sec-
- 14 retary shall ensure that grants under subsection (a) cover
- 15 a variety of diabetes-related health care services, including
- 16 routine care for diabetic patients, public education on dia-
- 17 betes prevention and control, eye care, foot care, and
- 18 treatment for kidney disease and other complications of
- 19 diabetes.
- 20 "(d) Appropriate Cultural Context.—A condi-
- 21 tion for the receipt of a grant under subsection (a) is that
- 22 the applicant involved agrees that, in the program carried
- 23 out with the grant, services will be provided in the lan-
- 24 guages most appropriate for, and with consideration for
- 25 the cultural backgrounds of, the individuals for whom the
- 26 services are provided.

- 1 "(e) Outreach Services.—A condition for the re-
- 2 ceipt of a grant under subsection (a) is that the applicant
- 3 involved agrees to provide outreach activities to inform the
- 4 public of the services of the program, and to provide offsite
- 5 information on diabetes.
- 6 "(f) APPLICATION FOR GRANT.—A grant may be
- 7 made under subsection (a) only if an application for the
- 8 grant is submitted to the Secretary and the application
- 9 is in such form, is made in such manner, and contains
- 10 such agreements, assurances, and information as the Sec-
- 11 retary determines to be necessary to carry out this section.
- 12 "(g) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—For the
- 13 purpose of carrying out this section, there are authorized
- 14 to be appropriated such sums as may be necessary for
- 15 each of the fiscal years 2010 through 2015.".

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
