3 SECTION 1. PRELIMINARY REPORT OF THE COMMISSION.

- 7 and inserting "the reports required"; and
- 8 (2) in subsection (h)—

1	(A) by redesignating paragraphs (2) , (3) ,
2	and (4) as paragraphs (3) , (4) , and (5) , respec-
3	tively;
4	(B) by amending the heading of paragraph
5	(1) to read as follows: "FINAL REPORT"; and
6	(C) by inserting after paragraph (1) the
7	following new paragraph:
8	"(2) PRELIMINARY REPORT.—Not later than
9	June 15, 2010, the Commission shall submit to the
10	President and to the Congress a report containing
11	the preliminary findings and conclusions of the Com-
12	mission on the causes of the current financial and
13	economic crisis in the United States.".

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
