A BILL

To amend the Fraud Enforcement and Recovery Act of 2009 to require the Financial Crisis Inquiry Commission to make a preliminary report no later than June 15, 2010.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PRELIMINARY REPORT OF THE COMMISSION.**

4 Section 5 of the Fraud Enforcement and Recovery
5 Act of 2009 is amended—

6 (1) in subsection (c)(3), by striking “a report”
7 and inserting “the reports required”; and

8 (2) in subsection (h)—

1 (A) by redesignating paragraphs (2), (3),
2 and (4) as paragraphs (3), (4), and (5), respec-
3 tively;

4 (B) by amending the heading of paragraph
5 (1) to read as follows: “FINAL REPORT”; and

6 (C) by inserting after paragraph (1) the
7 following new paragraph:

8 “(2) PRELIMINARY REPORT.—Not later than
9 June 15, 2010, the Commission shall submit to the
10 President and to the Congress a report containing
11 the preliminary findings and conclusions of the Com-
12 mission on the causes of the current financial and
13 economic crisis in the United States.”.

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
